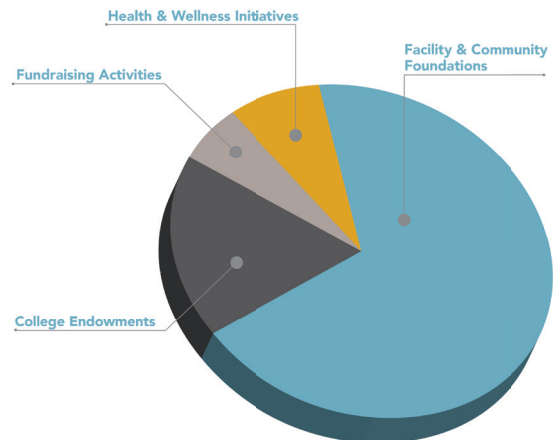
Our 2025 donation amounts totaled \$56,500 and broke out as follows:
